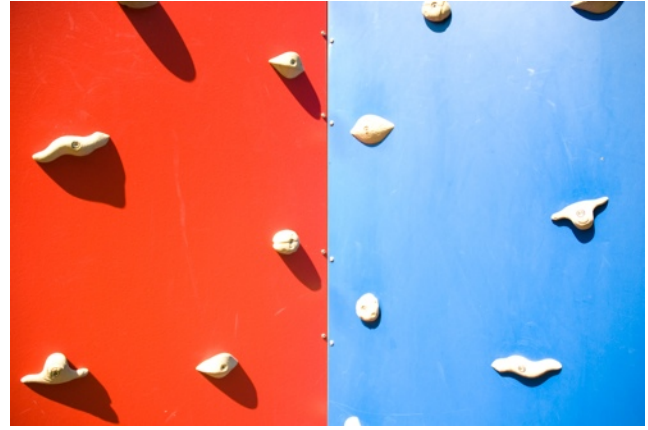
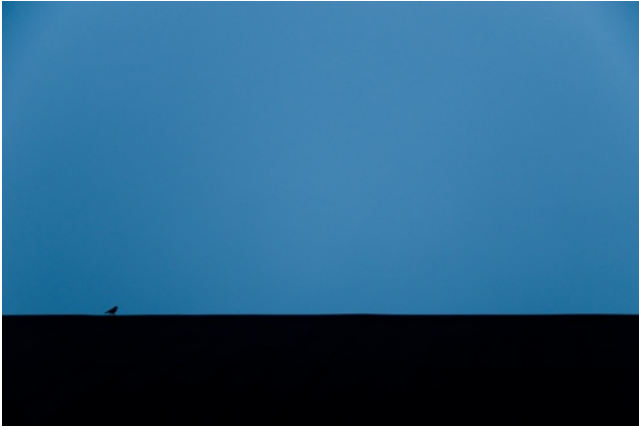

On Tuesday the 14th of December 2010 we have the honor of inviting you on a 'Tour de Oresund Region' within the Borderlands Seminar from 10.15 – 12. 00. The venue is Copenhagen University Amager, room 23.4.39 (New KUA). The Borderlands Seminar offers you six thematic stations presenting themes such as:

- The Constant Commuter: Free Newspapers as Travelling Objects
- Unsought Regionauts
- "My daddy is a regionaut". Family stories from the Oresund Region
- The new Generation of Regionauts
- Greasing the Wheels of the Oresund: Workers Narratives across the Swedish-Danish Border
