To students in the Bachelor programme in Development studies

You apply for the courses online at www.antagning.se. The application system opens September 15. Last date for application for the spring term 2021 is October 15. Go to “Your pages” and choose “Lund University” in the scroll list. Use your student account user ID to log in. That means you must have access to your student account and password.

If you lost your user ID or password, you can create a new using passport.lu.se where you log in with your personal ID and password from Antagning.se. You can also go to a student desk at the university and get a one-time code that you can use to set a new password. Need a new password for Antagning.se please contact Antagning.se this. Note that LU Service Desk cannot answer admissions questions.

When applying for elective courses, you are not guaranteed to be accepted to a certain course or a certain course package. However, as students on a Degree Programme, you are prioritized for the courses within the Faculty of Social Sciences.

Course application

If a course can be applied for either within your programme or as a free-standing course, you must actively choose one of the alternatives. As a student on a study programme you should put your alternatives within the program at the top of your application to minimize the risk of getting unnecessary gaps in your programme studies.

Observe! Even if you apply to both courses within your programme and (freestanding) single subject courses, you cannot be admitted to more than 45 credits in all.

You cannot register for more credits within your programme than your programme comprises. So, if you apply to courses within your programme and it turns out that you are already registered for the maximum credits, your application for those courses that exceed the maximum credit limit will be converted to (freestanding) single subject courses, if possible. Otherwise these courses will be deleted.

Appendices

Normally, no appendices need to be enclosed; however, please see enclosed instructions for your programme.

Selection results

The Notification of Selection Results is sent out the second week of December. If you have applied via www.antagning.se you will get an e-mail, to the e-mail address you have stated in your user account, with information that your selection result is available on “Your pages”.

Reply

Any student admitted or placed on a waiting list must respond. It is necessary to respond to the admissions decision no later than the date specified in the admissions decision; otherwise, you will lose your place. You are obliged to ensure that the decision reaches you. If you have not received the admissions decision by

December 11, please contact us at 0771-550720, so you have time to reply in time.

Failure to respond means that your place goes to another applicant.

Problem

If you fail with applying to your programme courses please contact your department or the Admissions Office before the last day for application.
